

When the result of your qualitative antigen self-test has showed positive:

Check if any of the following conditions are applicable to you.

- Individuals who are under the age of 65 and **reside in Hiroshima Prefecture** (including long-term resident)
- Individuals between the ages 40 and 64 and who are applicable to one or none of the health risk factors below.
*The health risk factors include:
Malignant tumor, chronic respiratory disease (COPD, etc.), chronic kidney disease, cardiovascular disease, cerebrovascular disease, hypertension, diabetes, dyslipidemia, obesity (BMI of 30 or higher), suppression of immune system caused by organ transplantation, use of immunosuppressants or anticancer drugs, etc.
- Individuals who currently are unlikely to be pregnant.
- Individuals** in stable condition with mild or no symptoms at the time of registration **who can confidently determine that a visit to a medical institution is not necessary**.
- Individuals who are able to be treated at home with the aid of OTC medications**.
- Individuals who can apply online.



*Children in sixth grade or younger should consult their doctor or a local pediatrician depending on the situation.
(Children under two years of age or with chronic condition may have higher health risk.)

The length of treatment period can be confirmed by using "Estimated treatment/waiting period calculation tool".

*1 Onset report: a doctor submits a report to a health care center when a patient is found to be COVID-19 positive.

Target groups are: individuals aged 65 years or above, individuals who require hospitalization, pregnant people, individuals with health risk and who require administration of a COVID medication, or individuals who need new oxygen administration due to COVID-19 infection.
